<p>Sound hunt - Find 10 items in the house that begin with the same sound as your name or someone else's in your family.</p> <p>OR</p> <p>Look at the picture of the penguins and polar bear below. What happened before? What do you think will happen next?</p>	<p>Make a fort - Use blankets, sheets, pillows, a table and other furniture to make a fort or secret hiding place. Then enjoy playing in your special place.</p> <p>Now, can you draw a picture of or tell a story with your fort in it? Where is it set? Who lives in it? What does it have inside</p>	<p>Find 5 - 10 items in the house. Arrange them from lightest to heaviest. Explain your thinking with someone and see if they agree with you.</p> <p>OR</p> <p>Measure how long your family is. Gather some socks from your drawers, arrange them on the floor, side by side, into a straight line. Get each member to lie down next to the socks, count how many socks long they are. Arrange members of your family from tallest to shortest.</p>	<p>Ask your child to point to his/her heart and feel their heartbeat. Explain the people and animals have a muscle that pumps blood throughout their body and that is what keeps them alive. Play an upbeat song and have your child dance or jog in place for a minute or two and then feel their heartbeat. Talk about the difference and why their heart is pumping faster. Next, have the child lie down for a minute or two and feel their heart afterward. If possible, show pictures of a human heart on your technology.</p>
