Make letters with your body. If you need an extra person, have a sibling or guardian help you try to make as many letters as you can. Try the letters L, O, K, T, and V by yourself!	Draw a map of the inside of your house. Don't forget to add details in your rooms!  Or  Make your own book about your adventures last week.	Build a tall tower. How many blocks high did you make your tower? Can you measure it with measuring tape/a ruler?  Or  Play dominoes / a board game / card game with your sibling/ parents/guardian.	Provide your child with blocks and small boards or cardboard to make ramps. Children can experiment with by rolling or sliding different objects down the ramps: blocks, boxes, cars, marbles, droplets of water, rocks. Why do certain things move differently than others?
